
**2010 FALL MIZISE (TURKEY) HUNTING REGULATIONS
MINNESOTA 1837 CEDED TERRITORY**

NOTE: The rules summarized in this leaflet are the minimum rules applicable to tribal members hunting turkeys off-reservation. **YOUR TRIBE MAY HAVE IMPOSED ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS OR REQUIREMENTS.** Check with your conservation department to see a complete copy of your tribe's ordinance, or to see if additional regulations apply to your hunting activities.

PERMITS: You must have a valid small game hunting permit in order to hunt turkeys in the fall season.

HUNTING HOURS: One-half hour before sunrise one half hour after sunset.

FALL SEASON DATES: Day after Labor Day through December 31.

CARCASS TAGS / BAG LIMITS: The bag limit is equal to the number of valid carcass tags in your possession. Generally, one carcass tag will be issued at a time; additional tags may be obtained after registering a turkey if the zone's quota has not been reached. Upon killing any turkey you must immediately affix the carcass tag to it.

WILD TURKEY PERMIT AREAS: The attached map displays permit area boundaries, and the approximate ceded territories line.

BEARDED VERSUS BEARDLESS HARVEST:

In all open zones EXCEPT 152,; You may take birds either bearded or beardless turkeys.

In zone 152: You may harvest **only** bearded turkeys.

REMAINDER OF THE 1837 MINNESOTA CEDED TERRITORY: No turkey hunting is allowed.

REGISTRATION: All turkeys killed must be registered by presenting the entire carcass to a band or GLIFWC warden or at a tribal registration station or no later than 5:00 p.m. of the next working day following the killing. You are required to accurately provide any information (such as the age and/or sex of turkey, or the location of harvest) requested at registration.

ALLOWABLE METHODS: No member shall hunt wild turkeys:

- a) By any means other than a 20 gauge or larger shotgun or muzzle-loading shotgun 12 gauge or larger, using fine shot size No. 4 or smaller diameter, or a bow and arrow or a crossbow.
- b) With the aid of recorded bird calls or sounds or electrically amplified imitations of bird calls or sounds.
- c) With the aid of dogs.
- d) With live decoys for the purpose of enticing wild turkeys.

OTHER RESTRICTIONS:

While hunting turkeys you must also comply with all other restrictions which apply to hunting generally, or to small game hunting specifically.
