## ANNOUNCEMENT:

**GLIFWC will be sponsoring an Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) HACCP workshop in partnership with MSU Sea Grant and the Keweenaw Bay Fish Hatchery.**

**A Preventative System to Control the Spread of Invasive Species:** AIS-HACCP is a self-inspection system for reducing the risk of spreading aquatic invasive species through aquaculture, hatchery, scientific, natural resource, and baitfish harvesting activities. This adaptable way to protect waterways from unwanted species was derived from HACCP methods required for the seafood industry and builds on Sea Grant's success in assisting industry compliance.

The workshop will start with AIS HACCP presentations by MSU Sea Grant staff held at the Casino's Chippewa room, followed by lunch (i.e. on your own), and then a tour of the Keweenaw Bay hatchery (i.e. 14359 Pequaming Road, L'Anse, MI 49946). After the hatchery tour, participants will return to the Chippewa room where they will form workgroups and prepare and present AIS HACCP plans. This provides participants the ability to apply the concepts learned earlier in the day in a "real world" setting.

**Participants must attend the entire day to have their travel costs reimbursed by GLIFWC.**

**Tribal employees currently working at a tribal fish hatchery, tribal bait businesses or tribal natural resource office:** GLIFWC will provide a hotel room for any tribal employee working for a GLIFWC member tribe (i.e. Fond du Lac, Mille Lacs, Red Cliff, Bad River, St. Croix, Lac Courte Oreilles, Lac du Flambeau, Sokaogon Chippewa, Lac Vieux Desert, Keweenaw Bay or Bay Mills) wishing to complete the one-day class. After participants complete the class, they will sign a GLIFWC travel form for food and mileage reimbursement based on GSA rates. Food and mileage reimbursements will be mailed to participants after processing by the GLIFWC's accounting office.

**Enrolled members of GLIFWC tribes who are operating a bait fish collection and distribution businesses in the Chippewa ceded territories.** GLIFWC will provide a hotel room for any enrolled member of a GLIFWC member tribe (i.e. Fond du Lac, Mille Lacs, Red Cliff, Bad River, St. Croix, Lac Courte Oreilles, Lac du Flambeau, Sokaogon Chippewa, Lac Vieux Desert, Keweenaw Bay or Bay Mills) actively collecting and selling bait under tribal off-reservation regulatory codes. After participants complete the one-day class, they will sign a GLIFWC travel form for food and mileage reimbursement based on GSA rates. Food and mileage reimbursements will be mailed to participants after processing by the GLIFWC's accounting office.
